New drop-off payment box available at new WMGLD  
facility on North Avenue; Albion Street drop-off eliminated

(Wakefield, MA) – Now that the Wakefield Municipal Gas & Light Department (WMGLD) is settled into its new home at 480 North Avenue in Wakefield, customers are now able to drop off their payments in a secure box outside the new facility’s main entrance during non-business hours.

As a result, the afterhours drop-off box at the WMGLD’s former business office at 9 Albion Street will be eliminated, effective Monday, June 24<sup>th</sup>.
