**WMGLD to participate in National Drive Electric Week
Ride and Drive on September 13th**

(Wakefield, MA) – The Wakefield Municipal Gas & Light Department (WMGLD) will participate in National Drive Electric Week with test drives and an opportunity to gather information about electric vehicles and chargers on Thursday, September 13th from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. in the customer parking lot at the WMGLD'S 480 North Avenue facility. The event will be a part of the national observance that will take place throughout the country from September 8th through 16th. The WMGLD event will also include give-aways and refreshments.

Representatives from Kelly Nissan, Quirk Chevrolet will join WMGLD staff to conduct test drives and answer questions about the vehicles, including the 2018 Nissan LEAF and the 2018 Chevy Bolt EV electric vehicles that are part of the WMLD's special rebates and tax incentive program available to WMGLD customers through the WMGLD's partnership with Nissan North America and participating Massachusetts and Connecticut dealers, and Quirk Chevrolet of Braintree. Tesla will also be in attendance displaying their Model X and answering any questions.

Customers who purchase a 2018 LEAF may be eligible for a savings of \$15,000 which includes a \$5,000 rebate off the MSRP, a Massachusetts EV incentive of \$2,500 and a \$7,500³ Federal tax incentive. The 2018 Chevy Bolt EV carries a \$6,600 Dealer Incentive and the

Massachusetts and Federal tax incentives of \$2,500 and \$7,500 respectively, for a potential savings of \$16,600.

This is a limited time offer on the purchase of a 2018 Nissan LEAF at a Nissan dealership or a 2018 Chevy Bolt EV at Quirk Chevrolet in Braintree. The rebates and incentives cannot be combined with any other Nissan or Chevy special lease, APR or rebate.

Customers who already own an electric vehicle can learn more about the free level 2 Wi-Fi enabled home charging station from WMGLD at the event.
