WMGLD to Hold Informational Meeting on Sense Home Energy Monitor

(Wakefield, MA) - The Wakefield Municipal Gas & Light Department (WMGLD) will hold an informational meeting via Zoom platform on Thursday, October 22nd at 7 p.m. to introduce the new Sense Home Energy Monitor rebate recently added to the WMGLD residential energy rebate program.

The meeting will include a presentation by a Sense representative who will demonstrate and explain the monitor, how it is installed and used, and the benefits to the customer. A question and answer session will also be held to allow customers to ask questions. WMGLD representatives will participate in the interactive Zoom meeting and will provide information about the rebate program.

Installed in the customer's electrical panel, the Sense Home Energy Monitor lets the user understand how much energy the home is using, see when and where the electricity is being used, and gather information to save energy. The monitor also lets the customer monitor the devices/appliances when in the home or away.

“The Sense Home Energy Monitor is the most recent addition to our expanding rebate program,” WMGLD General Manager Pete Dion said. “This informational session will enable us to not only introduce the rebate, but to also provide customers with a demonstration of the monitor and the ways it may help them save energy.”
