


Here's how it works:


WMGLD customers can choose to pay an additional \$.0184 per kilowatt-hour for the kilowatt hours they use and the department will purchase Massachusetts Class 1 Renewable Energy Credits (REC) to ensure that 100% of their energy supply is NON-CARBON EMITTING. Massachusetts Class 1 RECs support development of new renewable energy resources. The REC purchases through the CUSTOMER CHOICE program are above and beyond WMGLD's current requirements.
